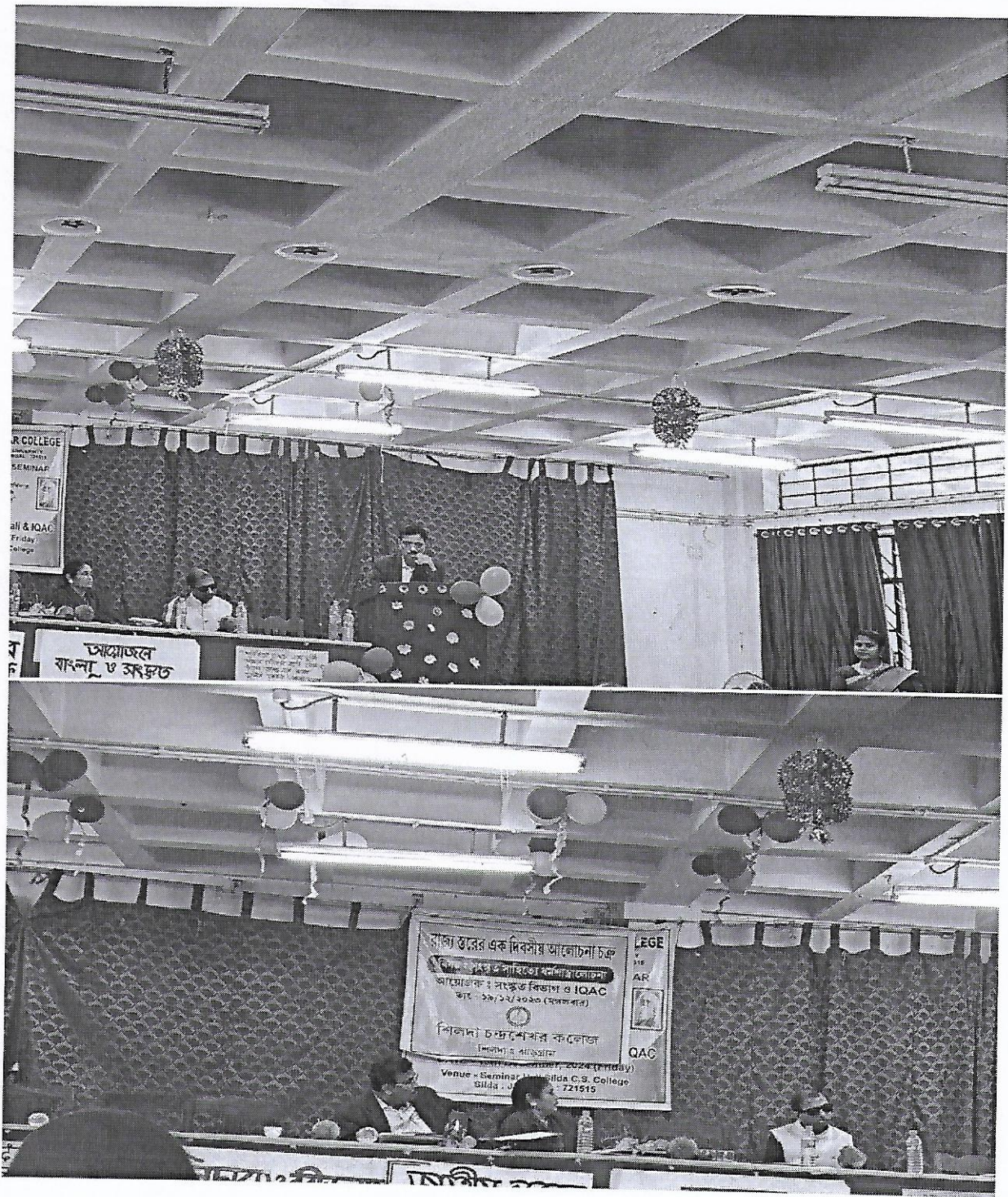


Report of Seminar on “Theological discussion in Sanskrit literature”
